

CAMELOT KENNELS - VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS.

Dear Pet Owner - Please note:

The Vaccination record section of the booking form MUST be completed and signed off by your vet before we can accept your pet(s) at Camelot. It is important to tell your vet when your pets are due to visit the kennels. Kennel Cough is not part of the normal annual update as there are different needs when they are going to be surrounded by other boarders.

The completed, signed Vac. 1[a] forms must reach our office no later than 14 days prior to check in. Failure to comply may result in the pets being turned away, or spending their holiday in a very expensive quarantine unit It is hoped that these steps will encourage clients to ensure their pets are vaccinated in time.

These precautions have been taken in the best interest of all clients, to eliminate the risk of infection or reduce the degree of doubt and confusion that exists regarding important vaccinations etc.

As a responsible pet owner, we know you will appreciate that your pets' wellbeing and health is of paramount importance to us.

It is very important to avoid contact with sick animals immediately before a visit to the kennels. Animals cannot be accepted if there is any risk that they may infect other boarders. Withholding such information is seen as a breach of trust and may lead to blacklisting.

Latent heart or other health problems.

Does any of the pets suffer from a weak heart, or any other serious health problems? Please provide the necessary, essential, information to allow us to adjust their daily routine as required.

If it is a high risk problem the pet may not be accepted in the kennels.
